MONTHLY RECIPE

Arcadia's Whitsun Ale

Ingredients for 5 U.S. gal (19 L)

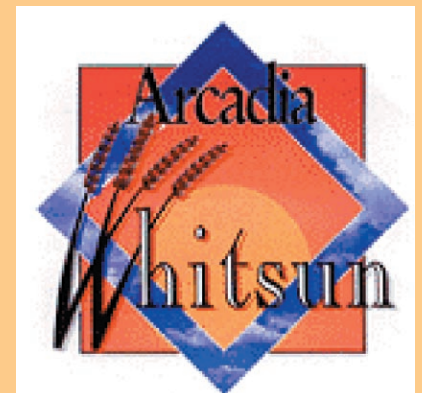
- 1.5 lbs Orange Blossom honey
- 4.25 lbs British Pale Ale malt
- 4.0 lbs British Wheat malt
- 1.0 lbs British Carapils malt
- 1.0 lbs British Munich malt
- 0.4 lbs Rice hulls
- 1.0 oz Hallertau (4.25%) hops 60 min

Wyeast 1187 Ringwood Ale Yeast

Instructions

Single temperature mash at 150°F for 60 minutes. Lauter carefully for 60 minutes. Boil for 10 min then add hops as a single charge and continue boiling for 60 more minutes. Add honey. Chill the wort and pitch a big yeast starter. This yeast is a tenacious top cropper so expect to have to beat it down into the wort more than once in order to complete fermentation.

This Month's Meeting is at Arcadia Brewing Co. !!!

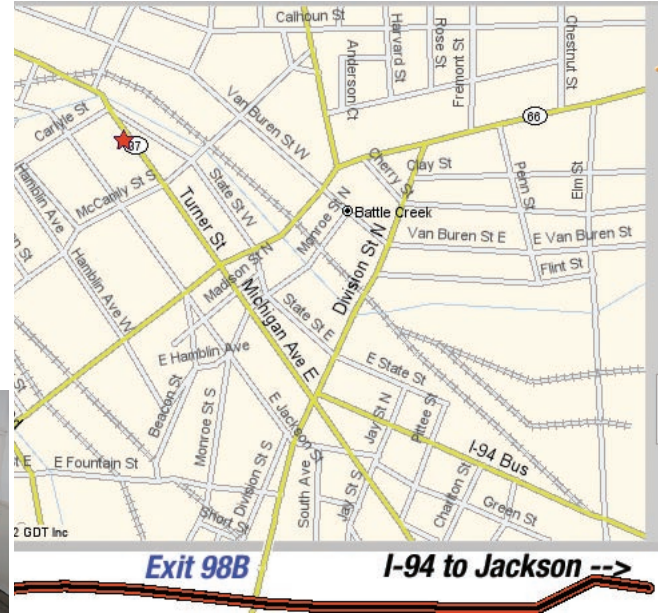
Take 94 West to exit 98B. This will be M-66 north.

Go to the 2nd stop light turn left; this will be Michigan Ave.

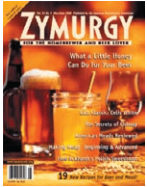
