2 Row 5.5 pounds

Corn 1.8 pounds

Chocolate 1.5 ounces

Barley 0.8 pounds

Crystal 20 0.5 pounds

Hops

Chinook 0.3 oz 60 min 14.5 % AA
19.9 ibu leaf

Kent Goldings 0.6 oz 15 min

5.7 % AA 3.9 ibu leaf

Irish Moss 1.0 package

Sparge water amount: 12.9 quarts

Sparge water temperature: 180 °F

Extraction efficiency: 72 %

Sparge liquor collected: 6.5 gallons

Mashing schedule

Wyeast #1084 Irish Ale

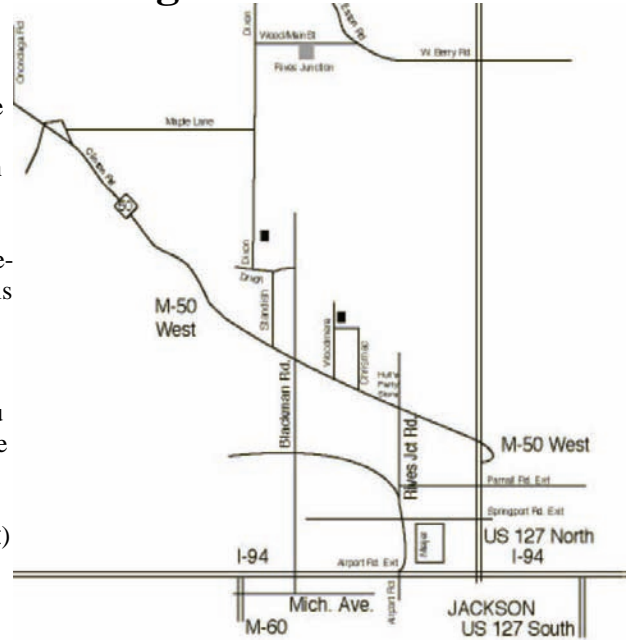
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Poison Frog beer makes it to the start of the Iditarod race in Alaska.
